The South River Water Department will begin its annual Spring Hydrant Flushing Program beginning on April 10, 2017 until approximately April 28, 2017.

## **RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

AREA #3 – Beginning April 10<sup>th</sup> to April 13<sup>th</sup> – 7:30 am to 2:30 pm Kamm Avenue to Veterans Drive (in all directions)

AREA #2 – Beginning April 17<sup>th</sup> to April 21<sup>st</sup> - 7:30 am to 2:30 pm Kamm Avenue to Jackson Street (in all directions)

AREA #1 – Beginning April 23<sup>rd</sup> to April 28<sup>th</sup> - 9:00 pm to 5:00 am Main Street (North End) to Pettit Avenue (in all directions)

**BUSINESS AREAS** (Main St, Ferry St, Obert St, Old Bridge Turnpike, Whitehead Ave & Jackson Street) – Week of April 23<sup>rd</sup> to April 28<sup>th</sup> - 9:00 pm to 5:00 am

During the hydrant flushing there may be a noticeable decrease in pressure, as well as a discoloration in the water. This is not physically harmful and will not affect the safety of the water for drinking and sanitation purposes. If this occurs, please run your COLD water for several minutes to clear your lines. You should also flush your toilets once or twice. The water should run clear within a few minutes.
