The Office on Aging has teamed up with eco-wise business, TerraCycle (terracycle.net), to collect waste materials that are not taken by our local recycling program. Terracycle will donate 2 cents to the South River Senior Trust Account for each non-recyclable cereal box, chip bag or other scrap that's sent in (they even pay for postage!). Then they upcycle the goods into unique, eco-friendly products, ranging from tote

bags and purses, to shower curtains and kites, which are sold at major retailers such as Target, The Home Depot, Petco and Whole Foods. By finding innovative uses for these products, the company prevents thousands of tons of waste from going to landfills. Be a part of our eco-revolution and start collecting the items listed below.
