Who: The South River Food Bank is open to South River residents who are in need of assistance to help close the gap in their monthly food budget.

Requirements:

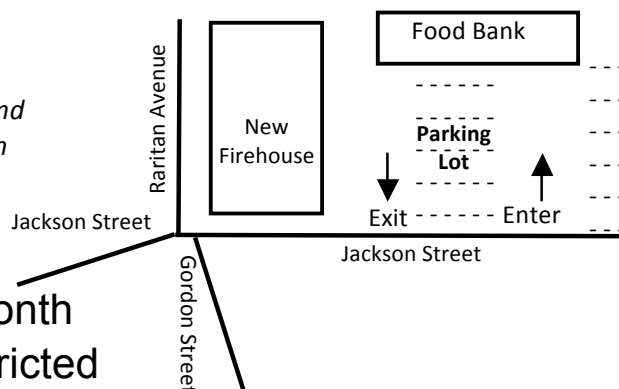
- Annual registration asserting your need.
(Refer to our 'Eligibility Guidelines' on our webpage for details.)
- Valid ID and current Proof of Residence at each visit.
(A current utility bill is preferred as Proof of Residence. Speak with a member of the food bank staff if you have questions.)

What: Two bags of groceries per household*.

- One bag of BASIC items.
- One bag of BONUS items selected from our bonus shelves.
BREAD and PRODUCE will be given if available.

Where: 98 Jackson Street, South River

The borough has arranged free transportation to and from the South River food bank for those who are in need of this service. Call the food bank or go to our webpage for details.



When: ONE visit per household* per month will be permitted. Visits are restricted to the posted Food Bank Hours.

***A single family home is considered one household no matter how many adults are living or renting rooms within the home.**

10 am – 12 noon

Open EVERY Wednesday and the first TWO Saturdays of the month

(Unless the building is closed due to weather or scheduled holidays.)
