APPROVED TREE SPECIES

The following trees are currently approved by the Environmental and Shade Tree Commission for planting in the borough. These trees fall into different categories that may not be appropriate in certain locations. The Environmental and Shade Tree Commission shall assist in making a determination about the proper tree for the dedication if a new tree is to be planted. This list is subject to change due to changing circumstances within the borough.

American Elm, Lacebark elm, Zlkova, Male Ginko, Pin Oak, Red Oak, White Oak, Swamp white Oak, Chestnut, Willow, Blackgum, Littleleaf linden, Freeman maple, Sycamore maple, Red Maple, Red Horsechestnut, European hornbeam, Hackberry, Katsura tree, Yellowwood, American hophornbeam, Eastern redbud, Trident maple, Hedge maple, Amur maple, American smoketree, Winter King Hawthorn, Persian parrotia, Japanese tree lilac.

Additional Details

Bench applications are submitted to the Parks & Recreation Department. Tree applications are submitted to the Environmental and Shade Tree Commission. All applications are subject to review from these bodies and will be evaluated within the confines of their strategic plans for the parks as well as the shade tree inventory. The purpose of these dedications is to provide small opportunities for residents of the borough to build connections and relationships with our public spaces and to memorialize the lives of residents who have contributed to the borough.

While we attempt to make every effort to accommodate requests, we cannot guarantee that specific requests for a dedication can be accommodated. This is due to a wide variety of factors related to the overall plans of the parks and our borough tree inventory. Dedication of trees and benches need not be limited to “new” plantings and placements, but may be considered for existing trees or benches in the borough.

Ultimately, our goal is to beautify our public spaces. These policies are subject to change due to changing circumstances within the borough.
